Jan Hess is the Executive Vice President and Chief Financial Officer and has held that position since 2007. She is the second-highest ranking officer for both the Engineered Systems and Energy and Power segments of Teledyne Technologies.

When Hess joined the company in 2000, she served as Vice President of Finance and Chief Financial Officer, responsible for all aspects of the financial operations of Teledyne Brown, including strategic financial planning, internal financial systems and auditing, procurement, contract administration, and accounting.

Prior to joining Teledyne Brown, Hess was Vice President of Finance and Administration and Chief Financial Officer for Intergraph Computer Systems, a Division of Intergraph Corporation, Huntsville, Alabama. Responsible for the financial operations of this \$250-million hardware division, Hess served on the executive management team that restructured the division, creating a successful exit strategy for the company's hardware operations.

From 1984 to 1998, Hess held various management positions with Intergraph, including Executive Manager and Assistant Controller. She managed the company's external financial reporting and analysis function, including all Securities and Exchange Commission reporting and worldwide compliance with GAAP. She was involved in all acquisitions and divestitures and participated in various overseas assignments. In her early career with Intergraph, Hess managed the International Financial Analysis organization, with over 30 international operations.

From 1981 to 1983, Hess served as an audit staff accountant with Price Waterhouse in Birmingham, Alabama.

At Auburn University, Hess majored in accounting, earning a B.S. in Business Administration degree with Honors. She also holds a Certificate in Management from Darden Graduate School of Business Administration, University of Virginia, and she is a Certified Public Accountant in Alabama (inactive).

Hess has experience serving on both for-profit and nonprofit boards of directors. She is a community volunteer. Hess is the recipient of the Women's Economic Development's Women Honoring Women award. She has also been a special topics speaker for the University of Alabama in Huntsville's School of Business.
